He was a member of the Rotary International Board of Directors in 2010-2012 and Chairman of the Executive Committee, 2011-2012. John has twice been a Delegate to the Council on Legislation and has served as a Rotary International Membership Coordinator, Regional Rotary Foundation Coordinator and Rotary Coordinator Training Leader. Currently John is Aide to the 2018 – 2019 Rotary International President.

Rochelle R. Hendricks



Rochelle R. Hendricks was named the first Secretary of Higher Education for the State of New Jersey in May 2011. As Secretary, she is responsible for policy and program development to enhance the capacity and competitiveness of New Jersey's higher education institutions. Secretary Hendricks has engaged the agency in the national higher education reform agenda while focusing on advancing the blueprint for reforming higher education recommended by the Governor's Higher Education Task Force chaired by Governor Kean, as well as the report issued by the UMDNJ Task Force chaired by Dr. Sol Barer. The office has been reorganized to enhance implementing the reform agenda which, with bipartisan support, has resulted in the largest academic merger in US history and the first higher education facilities funding in two decades.
